Serial Burglar Pleads Guilty, Faces Up to 7 Years in State Prison



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **BRANDON JIMENEZ**, 20, pleaded guilty to (2) Counts of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On June 18, 2012 **JIMENEZ** burglarized a home in the City of Albany. One of the items taken from the home included a Canon camera. **JIMENEZ** then pawned the camera at a local pawnshop and was observed on video selling the camera. On June 25, **JIMENEZ** and a co-defendant burglarized another home in the City of Albany, however, a police officer responded to the scene and **JIMENEZ** fled. **JIMENEZ** was later identified by a witness as the culprit. **JIMENEZ**'s co-defendant, **KAYAAN MARROW**, was also arrested.

JIMENEZ faces up to 7 years in State Prison when he is sentenced on November 15, 2012. The case against his co-defendant is still pending.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Legal Affairs Bureau handled the prosecution of this case.
