State Prison Sentence for Criminal Sale of Fentanyl



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KEITH STEVENS, 34, of Brooklyn, NY, was sentenced to 10 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On July 2, 2018, STEVENS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony.

On three separate occasions between October 11, 2017 and October 13, 2017, while on Central Avenue in the Town of Colonie, STEVENS sold a quantity of the narcotic drug fentanyl and

cocaine to another person in exchange for cash. These sales were captured on video surveillance.

Assistant District Attorney Alexander Scher of the Street Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
