## State Prison Sentence in Fatal Albany Shooting Case



**ALBANY, NY** – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that TRAYRON PALMER, 21, of Vergennes, VT, was sentenced to 23 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post- Release Supervision, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On March 1, 2019, PALMER pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Manslaughter in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony.

On June 12, 2018, PALMER and another individual intentionally shot at a group of people located on the front porch of a home on Livingston Avenue in the City of Albany. During the incident 20 year old Equan Fallen was shot in the chest and later died as a result of his injuries.

Deputy Chief Assistant Cheryl K. Fowler and Assistant District Attorney Collin D'Arcy handled the prosecution of this case.
