State Prison For Unlawful Sexual Surveillance



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that PATRICK KAISER, 54, of Canastota, New York, was sentenced to 2 to 4 years in State Prison before the Honorable Joseph Teresi in Albany County Supreme Court this morning. On November 7, 2012, KAISER pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Unlawful Surveillance in the First Degree as a Sexually Motivated Felony, a Class D Felony.

On September 23, 2012, KAISER was observed by an off-duty police officer in a Colonie grocery store sticking his foot between a woman's legs who was wearing a skirt when she was not paying attention. The women confronted KAISER, who fled the store, but was quickly apprehended. Police executed a search warrant of KAISER's vehicle and found a pen video camera, which contained several videos of undergarments of non-consenting females while they were not paying attention.

"I hope with today's state prison sentence, the victims of Mr. Kaiser can be provided with closure and the knowledge that justice has been served. I applaud the work of ADA Knowles for successfully prosecuting this case," commented DA Soares.

Assistant District Attorney Brett Knowles of the Special Victims Unit prosecuted this case.
