Tyler Pascuzzi Indicted for Aggravated Vehicular Homicide



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today announced that TYLER PASCUZZI, 26, of Cossackie, was arraigned for allegedly driving drunk and causing the death of two passengers of his speeding vehicle in a July 2014 crash on the New York State Thruway.

PASCUZZI was arraigned before Judge Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court today on (2) Counts of Manslaughter in the Second Degree, both Class C Felonies, (3) Counts of Aggravated Vehicular Homicide, all Class B Felonies, (3) Counts of Vehicular Manslaughter in the First Degree, all Class C Felonies, (2) Counts of Vehicular Manslaughter in the Second Degree, both Class D Felonies, (1) Count of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated, a Misdemeanor, (1)

Count of Driving While Intoxicated, per se, a Misdemeanor, (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Misdemeanor, and (1) Count of Reckless Driving, a Misdemeanor.

A Grand Jury previously returned an indictment alleging that at approximately 11:40 p.m., on July 4, 2014, PASCUZZI did allegedly cause the death of Alicia Tamboia and Cody Veverka while recklessly driving in an intoxicated state while operating a 2004 Volkswagen R32 at speed in excess of the posted limit on I-90 in the Town of Guilderland.

PASCUZZI pleaded not guilty to the charges today in court, and remains free on \$250,000 bail.

Vehicular Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter is prosecuting this case.
